## RESOLUTION OF THE LUKACHUKAI CHAPTER #036

# APPROVING AND ACCEPTING THE LUKACHUKAI CHAPTER TO INCREASE THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD BY \$100.00 EACH FOR ALL AWARD CATEGORIES, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2022.

### WHEREAS:

- 1. Pursuant to Navajo Nation Council Resolution No. CJ-20-55, dated November 14, 1955, the Lukachukai Chapter is vested with authority and charged with the responsibility to promote, protect and preserve the interest and general welfare, including the health and safety of its community people; AND
- 2. The Indian Self-Determination Act (P.L. 93-638) of the U. S. Congress and Local Governance Initiatives entitles and support us, Navajo Indians, in initiating plans making decisions, recommendation, request, etc., according to our actual needs and desires; AND
- 3. The Lukachukai Chapter awards Scholarships to qualified Lukachukai Chapter community members who meet eligibility through established policies and procedures; AND
- 4. The Navajo Nation appropriates annual funding each fiscal year to the Lukachukai Chapter that includes the Scholarship allocation; AND
- 5. The Lukachukai Chapter encourages the self-sufficiency of local community members through higher education and vocational/technical education; AND
- 6. The Lukachukai Chapter recognizes the economic impact of inflation and rising costs of higher education; AND
- 7. The Lukachukai Chapter increases the Scholarship funding in all award categories for A). Graduate (Master/PhD) student to \$600.00/semester, B). Undergraduate to \$500.00/semester, C). Part-time (3-11 hours) to \$300.00/semester, and D). Certificate/Vocational to \$300.00/semester; AND
- 8. The Lukachukai Chapter supports raising the Lukachukai Scholarship award in all above award categories.

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Lukachukai Chapter hereby approves and accepts to increase the Scholarship Award by \$100.00 each for all award categories, effective October 1, 2022.
